Waikanae Pool Trip

Only a week to go until our annual trip on Wednesday 21 February. This is such a fun day and a wonderful way for the whole school to reconnect and mark the beginning of another school year. It also leads onto heaps of awesome writing and recounts.

Please make sure your child/ren have morning tea, lunch and plenty of water packed for the day. Of course they will need a sunhat and named togs and towels. We ask that you sunblock your child/ren before coming to school but we will also take sunblock and will be getting the children to regularly reapply.
