Paid Union Meetings

For your information, the NZEI has called for Paid Union Meetings (PUMs) for teacher members. These are taking place online across the country this week. At the meetings, the teachers will discuss the proposed Time 4 Tamariki: Wāwāhi Tahā campaign. At this stage the main thrusts of the campaign are to increase staffing and teacher student ratios, non contact time, learning support, support for Maori and Pacifica teachers, and a pay increase to address rising cost of living.

Our staff will attend their hour-long sessions on Friday 17 June. To accommodate the meetings, we will have an alternative programme. We have done this to avoid asking parents to organise an early pick up of their children. As you know, our teachers do an amazing job and your support as they negotiate their next Collective Agreement is much appreciated.
