Learning Conversations

Learning Conversations are set for 12 and 13 April. Bookings are now open on www.schoolinterviews.co.nz and the code is **a83rm**. For online conversations, when you book you will need to enter the phone number you will be monitoring for a call. When your booking time arrives you will open the confirmation email and click on the link provided alongside the teacher name, date and time of booking. This will take you to the teacher's waiting room. The teacher will admit you to the call from the waiting room and also end the call.



In regards to the face to face meetings, we do ask that masks are worn by adults (and children from year 4 upwards). There will be plenty of space in the rooms and we will ensure that doors or windows are open to promote good ventilation.

The conversations are an excellent chance to check in on progress with in regards to hauora and academic learning and to keep working together in partnership. The conversations will not be 'student led' but it is still important and beneficial that your child is there as they are certainly central to everything.

KETE (Kids Enhancing the Tawa Ecosystem)

Covid Update

I am pleased to report that we are seeing a reduction in the number of people who have Covid here at Greenacres. Currently, we have 7 active student cases. We have also seen a reduction in the number of children at home isolating as a 'Household contact' which stands at 5. This is a positive trend and reinforcement that measures put in place are working well. Together we are doing amazingly. Let's keep it up.

You will have seen in the news on Monday that we remain at Red level of the Traffic Light System. Therefore the information provided last week is still current: .

- Masks continue to remain a requirement for staff working indoors with children and young people in Years 4-13
- We will continue to limit the number of people coming onto site so drop offs and pick ups at the gate and our staggered finish will remain
- Masks are not required outdoors
- There is now no capacity limits for outdoor events and activities
- Indoor capacity limits for extra-curricular activities have increased to 200 people (although we are conscious of overcrowding as per the recommendations.

Cabinet meets on April 14 to review the Traffic Light setting. Let's hope we go back into Orange and we will all be watching this closely. If this happens, we will communicate with you about how this will impact us at Greenacres School. It is our hope that we will be able to get back to normal as soon as possible.
